



The NHL & NHLPA celebrated a successful 6th year of the Future Goals Most Valuable Teacher Program.

New this year, the nomination process was opened to the public allowing anyone the ability to nominate a teacher who has made an impact in their community by using the sport of hockey to educate students on STEM concepts. Once finalists were selected via a panel, a public vote was held in the month of March.

Mr. Nareg Dekermenjian, from the LA Kings market, was announced as the 2025 Most Valuable Teacher of the Year, during Teacher Appreciation Week. A 5th grade teacher at Dixie Canyon Elementary School, Mr. Dekermenjian, integrated hockey into his health lessons, focusing on the nutritional and physical aspects, while also teaching his students how teamwork can improve mental health and build lasting friendships.

As part of his celebration, Nareg was provided tickets to an upcoming NHL event, in recognition of his commitment and dedication to his classroom and community.

To date, 327 extraordinary teachers across North America have been recognized and \$265,000 dollars have been distributed to support communities and school districts through technology and sustainability.
